Synopsis

In a generation technology has exploded and students come to school dressed like comic book characters in their bright vivid colors.

Color is an integral part of the high school Visuals Arts curriculum. Painting is a difficult medium. It is often frustrating for the adolescent because they have an idea of what they want their end result to be and do not understand how to make it happen. The activities in this unit relate to color such as color mixing, research of historical palettes and the use of those colors in works of art.
