Appendix- Common Core Standards

Reading Standards

- Read closely to determine what the text says explicitly and to make logical inferences from it; cite specific textual evidence when writing or speaking to support conclusions drawn from the text. Students will be given multiple sources to research, read and evaluate content which will be synthesized into a class presentation. Historical events will be integrated into political events to determine how they connect.
- Integrate and evaluate content presented in diverse formats and media, including visually and quantitatively, as well as in words. Students will research their given topic through websites as well as textbooks and political platforms to create a class presentation.
- Analyze how two or more texts address similar themes or topics in order to build knowledge or to compare the approaches the authors take. Students will synthesize the information presented through multiple sources to gain a new understanding of a political convention and election.

Writing Standards

- Produce clear and coherent writing in which the development, organization, and style are appropriate to task, purpose, and audience. Students will create a PowerPoint presentation detailing the information they gained through their research. They will determine the best writing style to disseminate the information to the rest of the class.
- Use technology, including the Internet, to produce and publish writing and to interact and collaborate with others. Students will use a Web Quest to investigate a given political convention and create a PowerPoint presentation within their group to present to the entire class.
- Conduct short as well as more sustained research projects based on focused questions, demonstrating understanding of the subject under investigation. Students will research a given political convention within their group and determine the impact of historical events on the convention.
- Gather relevant information from multiple print and digital sources, assess the credibility and accuracy of each source, and integrate the information while avoiding plagiarism. Students will gather information from multiple sources and determine relevant information to present to the class, citing their sources within their presentations.
