... is the absence of violence or fear of violence.


POSITIVE PEACE

Anchor Tools: 8 Pillars of Peace, Galtung's Triangle, Conflict Tree








Birmingham rated 14th worst US city for year-round particulate air pollution.

struggles with hunger.


Per capita, the number of people who die of violence in Birmingham is higher than Detroit.
